## EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT BACKGROUND

- Early Childhood Development (ECD) is defined as a process of emotional, cognitive, sensory, spiritual, moral, physical, social and communication development of children from birth to school going age.
- Policy Mandates:
  - > Constitution;
  - ECD Policy; and
  - Children's Act
- The Children's Act (No. 38 of 2005) dictates that Early Childhood Development services must be registered and comply with the following prescribed Norms and Standards of Chapter 5 and 6 of the Children's Act.





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#### NORMS AND STANDARDS FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT

#### SECTION 79(2): CHAPTER 5

- A safe environment for children
- Proper care for sick children or children who become ill
- Adequate space and ventilation (electricity and sanitation)
- Safe drinking water
- Hygienic and adequate toilet facilities(Ablution facilities)
- Safe storage of anything that may be harmful to children
- Access to refuse disposal services or other adequate means of disposal of refuse generated at the partial care facility
- A hygienic area for the preparation of food for children
- Measures for the separation of children of different age groups
- The drawing up of action plans for emergencies
- The drawing up of policies and procedures regarding health care at the partial care facility

#### **SECTION 94(2): CHAPTER 6**

- The provision of appropriate developmental opportunities
- Programmes aimed at helping children to realize their full potential
- Caring for children in a constructive manner and providing support and Security
- Ensuring development of positive social behavior
- Respect for and nurturing of the culture, spirit, dignity, individuality, language and development of each child.
- Meeting the emotional, cognitive, sensory, spiritual, moral, physical, social and communication development needs of children







## **IMPORTANCE OF ECD**

- Early childhood Development (ECD) has been identified as one of the Apex priorities of the Government of South Africa and is supported by legislation, National policies and strategies.
- The improvement of ECD services is recognized as part of Outcome 1: Improving Quality Basic Education in terms of the government focus areas.
- The government of South Africa supports an integrated approach to Early Childhood Development and believes that every child has the right to the best possible start in life.
- The Department of Social Development in line with the provisions of the Children's Act is responsible for the provision monitoring, registration, funding and expansion of ECD services.
